

Career Impact Workshop

An introduction to jobs that (really) make a difference

A huge number of people want to have a positive impact with their careers. However, it's often hard to know what we can do to make a real difference.

During this free online workshop, participants will be introduced to what we've identified as some of the most promising careers based on Probably Good's extensive research, drawing from scientific literature, case studies, and interviews with experts. In addition, we'll introduce tools participants can use to find opportunities relevant to them after the workshop.

We'll emphasize the surprisingly large difference between how much positive impact different careers can have. We'll also explore how using analytical reasoning to identify a higher-impact career could enable people to help others at a truly enormous scale—and hopefully feel fulfilled along the way. By the end, participants should have a better understanding of the next steps they can take to find a career that's both good for them and good for the world.

Who this is for

This workshop is for people who want to pursue a career that makes a positive difference in the world but feel unclear about how to do this. It will provide the most value for students and people early on in their careers, though we can tailor its content for other audiences.

Workshop structure

This workshop will run for one hour. After an introduction and overview of the workshop we'll cover the following topics:

- The world's most pressing issues and why choosing which problem to work on can greatly affect how much social impact you're able to achieve.
- Some of the most promising career paths we've identified through our research and ideas for how participants can identify high-impact roles for themselves.
- The importance of finding a role that fits the participants' skills, personality, and sources of motivation.
- Further resources and opportunities to help participants on their next steps towards finding a great career.

Throughout the workshop, there will be opportunities for participants to discuss these ideas amongst themselves and get feedback from their peers.
